Parking:

CATS Workshops



CATS offers people with disabilities are offering weekly workshops to assist people with disabilities, their families and their support staff to learn about and implement assistive technology.

The workshops will be held in the CATS room at North Parramatta.

These will run by experienced CATS occupational therapist and/or speech pathologist.

You have a choice of three workshops

1. Training Sessions

These sessions are designed to provide practical instruction in the use and implementation of strategies, software and technology.

Sessions include:

- using notetakers - Neo or Dana
- Develop switch skills, includes information on resources
- Develop choice making skills
- Using SwitchIt! Maker 2, including video editing
- Using Chooselt! Maker 2
- Learn to use Clicker 5 (one component of Clicker 5 addressed each week)
- Learn to use ClozePro
- Communication Across the Day
- Designing a communication book/board
- Designing a device overlay, e.g. GoTalk, Macaw, etc
- Learn about Auditory scanning communication strategies
- Makaton Basic Workshop (need to attend three consecutive sessions to receive a Certificate of Completion)
- Key Word Sign practice sessions

Frequency: one session per week

Duration: 2 hours

Style: small groups

Prerequisite: Basic skills in computer use

Who can attend: families and support staff of people with disabilities

2. Resource Development Sessions

These sessions are designed to computer stations with the latest software to use to develop resources.

Software programs include:

- SwitchIt! Maker 2
- Chooselt! Maker 2
- First Keys 2
- Clicker 5
- Cloze Pro
- PowerPoint
- PhotoStory
- Boardmaker
- DynaVox V software
- Speaking Dynamically Pro

Frequency: one session per week

Duration: 2 hours

Style: each participant creates resources using software programs relevant to the person with disability they are supporting

Prerequisite: Basic skills in computer use

Who can attend: families and support staff of people with disabilities

3. Consultation Sessions

These sessions are designed to look at and discuss technology for a particular client in consultation with a CATS speech Pathologist or Occupational Therapist.

Frequency: by appointment only

Duration: 30 minutes

Style: one on one
