


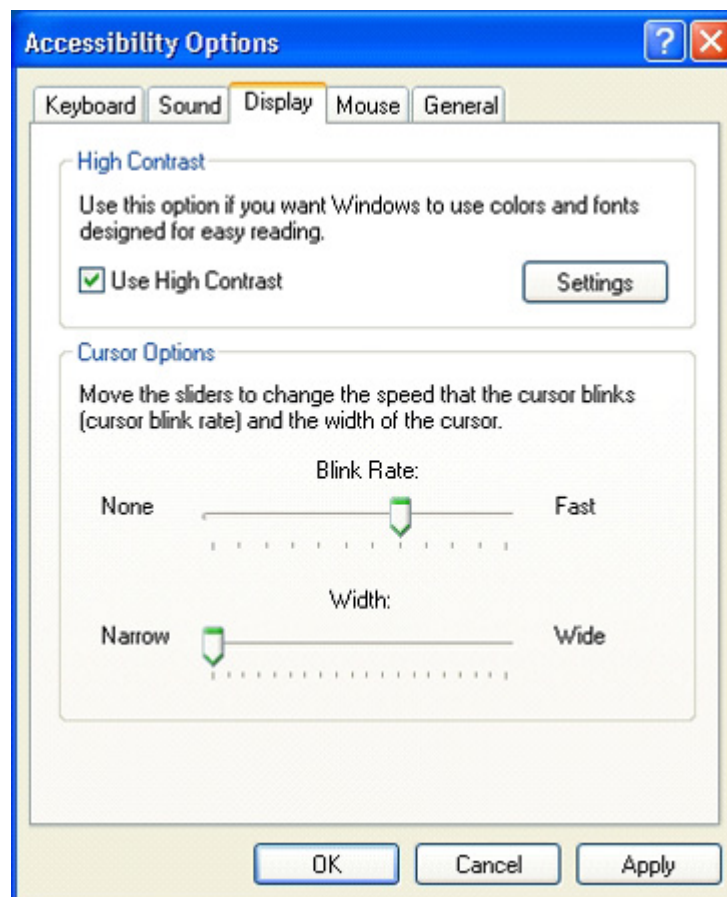
## High Contrast Colour Combination to Improve Screen Resolution - Windows XP

**High Contrast** is an accessibility feature designed for people who have vision impairment. High Contrast color schemes can increase legibility for some users by heightening screen contrast with alternative color combinations. Some of the schemes also change font sizes for greater legibility. This procedure tells you how to turn on High Contrast through **Accessibility Options** in **Control Panel**.

1	<p>On the <b>Start</b> menu:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select <b>Control Panel</b></li> </ul>	<p>Display the <b>Start</b> menu by pressing CTRL+ESC (or the Windows logo key .</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select <b>Control Panel</b> by pressing C.</li> </ul>
2	<p>In <b>Control Panel</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be sure you are in <b>Classic View</b> (all Control Panel icons are showing).</li> <li>If not, under <b>Control Panel</b> in the left pane, select <b>Switch to Classic View</b>.</li> <li>Select <b>Accessibility Options</b>.</li> </ul>	<p>In <b>Control Panel</b>:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Be sure you are in <b>Classic View</b> (all Control Panel icons are showing).</li> <li>If not, under <b>Control Panel</b> in the left pane, select <b>Switch to Classic View</b> by pressing TAB.</li> <li>Press ENTER.</li> <li>Press the RIGHT ARROW key, and then the LEFT ARROW key to select <b>Accessibility Options</b>.</li> <li>Press ENTER.</li> </ul>
3	<p>In the <b>Accessibility Options</b> dialog box:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select the <b>Display</b> tab.</li> </ul>	<p>In the <b>Accessibility Options</b> dialog box:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select the <b>Display</b> tab by pressing CTRL+TAB.</li> </ul>
4	<p>On the <b>Display</b> tab: To turn on High Contrast:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select the <b>Use High Contrast</b> check box.</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> To turn off High Contrast, clear the <b>Use High Contrast</b> check box.</p>	<p>On the <b>Display</b> tab: To turn on High Contrast:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select the <b>Use High Contrast</b> check box by pressing U.</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b> To turn off High Contrast, clear the <b>Use High Contrast</b> check box by pressing U.</p>

5	To access High Contrast settings: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select <b>Settings</b>.</li> </ul>	To access High Contrast settings: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select <b>Settings</b> by pressing S.</li> </ul>
6	In the <b>Settings for High Contrast</b> dialog box: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select the check boxes of the options you want.</li> <li>• Select <b>OK</b> twice to save your settings and close the dialog boxes.</li> </ul>	In the <b>Settings for High Contrast</b> dialog box: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select <b>Use shortcut</b> by pressing U.</li> <li>• Select a high contrast appearance scheme by pressing Y, and then pressing the UP ARROW and DOWN ARROW keys.</li> <li>• Press ENTER twice to save your settings and close the dialog boxes.</li> </ul>
7	To close <b>Control Panel</b> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select the <b>Close</b> button.</li> </ul>	To close <b>Control Panel</b> : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Press ALT+F, C.</li> </ul>
